





While looking through the buses, Paul discovered several things out of order such as brake and clutch lines cut. Distributor Caps on the roof of the school, etc.


Later in the morning, the local police arrived on the scene. They proceeded to take fingerprints from the buses and left to work on the case. What a beginning!
