After graduating from the school of medicine, Brenda Luckett settled down to being a doctor in good old Wright City.

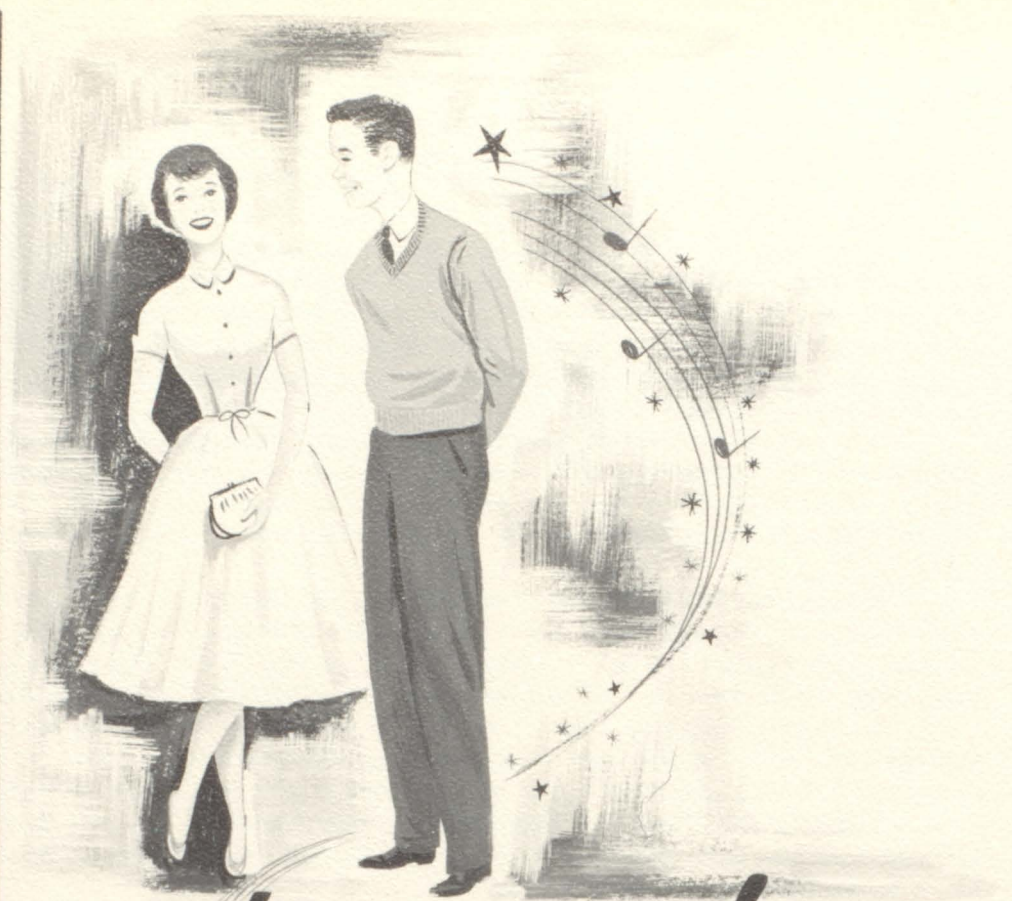
Gerald Schindler decided he wanted to get away from it all so he joined the Foreign Legion. He is really away from it all now in the middle of the Sahara Desert.
