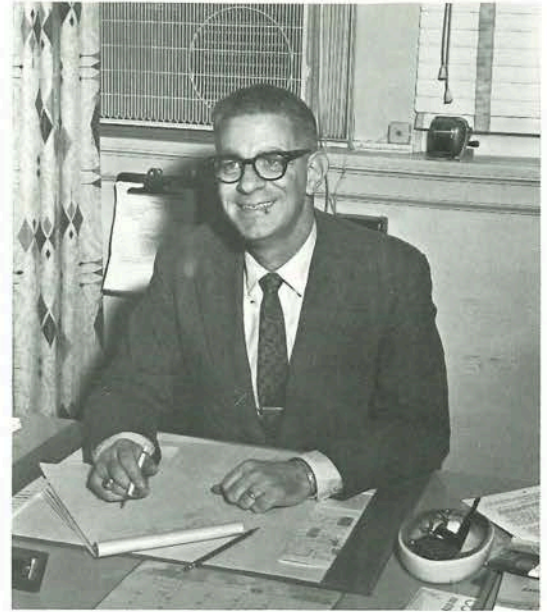
Fraser C. Small

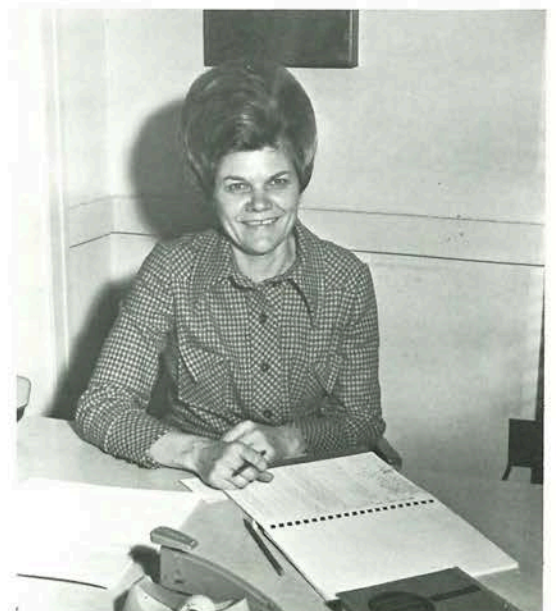
Iris J. Schaper
